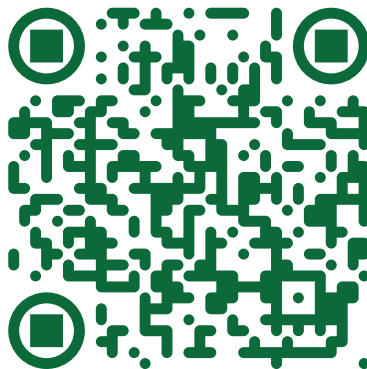

# Who are Greens in exile?

We are a group of long-serving and loyal Green Party members who have been suspended, expelled or forced to resign because governance bodies of the Green Party have been captured by Gender Ideologues\*, who are not guided by science, open discussion or natural justice but are intent on silencing debate and removing anyone who stands in their way.

**The complaints system has been abused, three of our national governance bodies are failing and freedom of speech in the Party is under threat**

Governance structures must be reformed so that never again can any tiny faction seize control. Three current GPRC motions to Conference seek to consolidate that control.

Good people need to be elected to the various Governance bodies.

The Disciplinary and Complaints system needs a complete overhaul.

## How could it happen in the Green Party?

The Green Party was set up to “Do Politics Differently”. We understood ecology and the impact of humans on our planet. The ozone layer, climate change, medicine - **we followed the science.**

As the Green Party has grown, some of our founding principles have been modified, but we held firm. Then along came Gender Ideology†.

All members, including Gender Ideologues and Gender Critical‡ members, should be able to express their views. A broken system has allowed one faction to gain control, abuse their powers and silence debate. We must reclaim the Party for all its members with the common goal of a better future.

## Who is running the Green Party?

Gender Ideologues have been elected into the Regional Council (GPRC), Standing Orders Committee (SOC) and Disciplinary Committee (DC) and have used these positions to promote their ideology rather than carry out their duties fairly and without bias.
